### **Theatre Facilitator / Workshop Instructor**

**(Part-Time, Contract)**

The Association of the Inside Out Integrated Theatre Project (Inside Out Theatre) enables participants with mixed-abilities to enjoy, participate in, and benefit from the development of a theatre training program and workshop atmosphere. We provide low-cost, accessible theatre education, resulting in increased self-confidence, functional literacy, and interpersonal skills for participants. Through workshops and public and invited audience performances Inside Out Theatre promotes visibility, diversity and disability culture.

We are seeking part-time Facilitators and Instructors for contract positions. There are both Lead and Support positions available. You will guide, or help guide, mixed-ability participants through theatre workshop sessions that focus around fun, confidence-building, trust, skill-building, theatre activities and games, and possibly a performance by the end of the sessions. Typically a program runs over 12 weekly sessions in both the fall and spring of a year. There is often a summer session as well. Check our website for a list of programs we offer. Positions are available for those programs.

Facilitators should have previous experience teaching theatre, and preferably have post-secondary theatre education. We are looking for a professional-like theatre workshop experience for participants, and Lead Facilitators should be able to host and offer such. Support Facilitators support lead positions. Experience in working with people of disability, Theatre of the Oppressed, a background in developmental drama / education, or as a drama or music therapist, is a strong asset.
